IMPORTANT: THIS AGREEMENT SETS FORTH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR LICENSING THE SOFTWARE FROM INTUIT TO YOU AND INSTALLING THE SOFTWARE INDICATES THAT YOU HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS AGREEMENT AND ACCEPT ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS. THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT ARE IN ADDITION TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONTAINED IN THE QUICKBOOKS SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT CONTAINED WITHIN THE SOFTWARE.

This Small Business Training Site License Agreement (“Agreement”) sets forth the terms under which Intuit Inc. (“Intuit”) will provide units of its QuickBooks® software (“Software”) to the Small Business Training Site (“Licensee”).

1. Grant of Rights and Restrictions. Intuit hereby grants Licensee a limited non-exclusive and non-transferable license to use the Software, and accompanying written materials if any (“Documentation”), for **instructional purposes only** (i.e., instruction in general accounting and/or personal finance principles, and not for accounting or personal finance services for the personal or commercial benefit of Licensee or others) for the maximum number of computers specified in the reverse side of this Agreement. The use of the Software is subject to the terms and conditions of Intuit’s standard end user license terms contained within the Software. Licensee may not reproduce the Software except as authorized by this Agreement, and may not modify, adapt, reverse engineer, decompile or disassemble the Software and may not deliver copies to, or rent, assign, loan, sell, lease or sublicense the Software or Documentation to anyone else or create derivative works based upon the Software or Documentation or any part thereof. Licensee shall use its best efforts to prevent unauthorized duplication of the Software or Documentation by Licensee’s employees, students, or others with access to the Software or Documentation.

2. Indemnification. Licensee agrees that Intuit is not liable for any claim by any third party arising out of the use of the Software or Documentation, and Licensee agrees to defend, indemnify and hold Intuit and its officers, directors, agents and employees and its affiliates harmless from and against any and all claims, damages, demands, liabilities, actions, judgments, losses, and expenses, including reasonable fees, costs, and expenses of attorneys, paralegals, and other professionals, arising out of or related to any such claim.

3. Term. This Agreement is effective until one (1) year after Licensee’s acceptance date for the Software, until the Licensee upgrades to a newer version of the software, or until terminated, whichever comes first. Licensee may terminate this Agreement by destroying all copies of the Software and Documentation and informing Intuit in writing that it has done so. Either party may terminate this Agreement immediately if the other party breaches any provision and does not cure such breach within thirty (30) days of notice from the non-breaching party. Intuit may terminate this Agreement for any reason on thirty (30) days notice.

4. Audit and Inspection Rights. Licensee agrees to allow Intuit and/or Intuit’s independent accountants to audit Licensee’s books and records related to this Agreement, and to inspect Licensee’s premises, to confirm the number of computers upon which the Software is installed and to confirm that adequate security measures have been maintained. Any such audit shall be permitted by Licensee within ten (10) days of Licensee’s receipt of Intuit’s written request, during normal business hours. The cost of audit will be borne by Intuit, unless such audit discloses that the Software has been installed upon unauthorized computers resulting in a shortfall in payment to Intuit of more than five percent (5%), in which case the cost of the audit will be borne by Licensee.

5. Additional Restrictions. Because of the financial nature of Intuit’s business, Intuit’s products and services are not designed to appeal to children under the age of 13, and Licensee agrees that it shall not permit persons under the age of 13 to access or use the Software or Documentation.

6. This Agreement is intended for use by Intuit approved, nonprofit small business training programs only and not as part of a degree program at an educational institution.
